Summer Sizzler promotion is available on the five half-day Learn to Sail course package and the Fast Track to Cruising course aboard monohulls, combining two days of learning on the Colgate 26, with a week aboard (or staying ashore) a 40'-50' cruising yacht. In the Fast Track to Live Aboard Cruising course, all provisions are included aboard the boat for the week, except two dinners ashore. This popular combination course provides three US Sailing certifications, Basic Keelboat, Basic Cruising, and Bareboat Charter Cruising, enabling one to skipper a boat up to 50'.
