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Learn to Sail in Florida



Your sailing fantasy may skew toward the dreamy drift of a Jimmy Buffett lyric. But a sailing reality requires technical knowledge— and practice. Which is why renowned sailor and competitor Steve Colgate and his wife, Doris, have built instructional rigor into their [Offshore Sailing School](#) programs: Even novice sailors emerge with a real set of sea legs. And there may be no better place to learn those ropes than at [South Seas Island Resort](#), a beloved [Captiva Island](#) institution on Florida's Gulf Coast. Offshore's five-day Learn to Sail package on Captiva includes afternoons off for exploring this

seashell-rich barrier island. If you're pressed for time, go for the two-day accelerated package, or get a taste with a two-hour sailing lesson. Experienced sailors can book packages such as Bareboat Charter Cruising and Coastal Navigation & Passage Making, among others.
